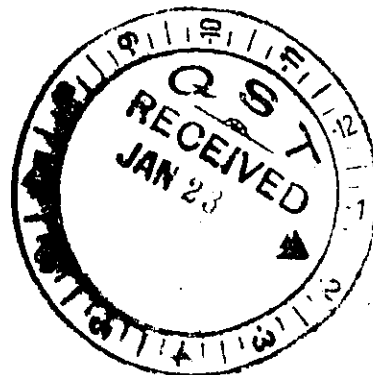
Said club to be known as the Motor City Radio Club.

BY-LAWS

1. Election of officers to be by direct vote of the electors.
2. Duties of officers.

a. President.

It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings, and to execute the decisions of the Club to the best of his ability.

The President shall have charge of the meetings, and as Chairman all motions shall be addressed to him or to the Chair as the case may be.

b. Vice President.

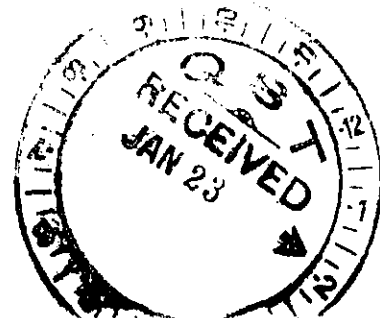
The Vice President shall assume the duties of the President in his absence.

His authority while acting as chairman shall be the same as those of the President.

c. Secretary Treasurer.

It shall be the duty of the Secretary Treasurer to record all meetings, to collect dues, to keep a record of attendance and to notify all members of all ordinary and special meetings.

3. All terms of office shall be for six months.
4. All vacancies other than that of President shall be filled by direct ballot, Vice President to succeed President for balance of term of Office.
5. All voting shall be by direct ballot.
6. Only members holding first class amateur or equivalent license may vote.
7. Anyone with an interest in short wave radio or amateur radio may become members.
8. All subjects brought up for discussion must be addressed to the Chair.



BY-LAWS (CONT.)

9. Dues of five cents a week to be collected indefinitely.
10. Meetings will be held every Friday at seven P.M. at 9199 Fort Street, West. (38 fj1).
11. Two thirds of the voting membership shall constitute a Quorum.
12. Membership fee to be fifty cents (.50).
13. Amendments to the constitution may be made or repealed by a two third majority of the electors.
14. Any member absent, unless excused from three consecutive meetings shall be automatically dropped from the roster.
15. Executive and special committees shall be appointed by the three Officers.
